- 2. First Fridays for Families: A free program that introduces kids to performing arts

411 Gallery is a **platform for local and regional artists** to share their work and helps to **build a sense of community** around the arts.

- Artist Pierre Obondo discusses the paintings he created while working in CAAC's studio space.




2023 FUND A NEED: HEALING THROUGH ART

- Program series that addresses the mental health crisis through creative expression.
- Various art forms including, music, visual arts, writing, dance
- Participants: teens, adults, recovery communities

"Healing through Art" is a series of arts programming that aims to address the crucial issue of mental health through the power of creative expression. Through a series of events and activities, we hope to provide a space for individuals to explore and process their emotions, improve their mental health, and build a sense of community.

The programming includes a variety of art forms, such as music, visual arts, creative writing, and dance. Each event is designed to be inclusive, accessible, and welcoming to individuals of all ages and backgrounds, with no previous experience or skill level required. All programming is offered free of charge to the community.

Participants will have the opportunity to engage in a range of activities that explore different facets of mental health, including coping mechanisms, self-care practices, and building resilience. Events will also feature mental health professionals and advocates, providing a platform for attendees to learn about available resources and support.
